- A **SUBJECT PRONOUN** takes the place of a subject (normally at the <u>beginning</u> of the sentence)

Amy is a student.

She is a student.

- An **OBJECT PRONOUN** takes the place of an object (normally <u>after a verb</u> or a <u>preposition</u>)

Do you know **Amy**?

Do you Know **her**?

- **POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVES** are followed by a noun

This is **my** book.

- **POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS** are used alone.

This book is **mine**.
