- A **SUBJECT PRONOUN** takes the place of a subject (normally at the beginning of the sentence)

Amy is a student.

She is a student.

- An **OBJECT PRONOUN** takes the place of an object (normally after a verb or a preposition)

Do you know Amy?

Do you know her?

- **POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVES** are followed by a noun

This is my book.

- **POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS** are used alone.

This book is mine.
